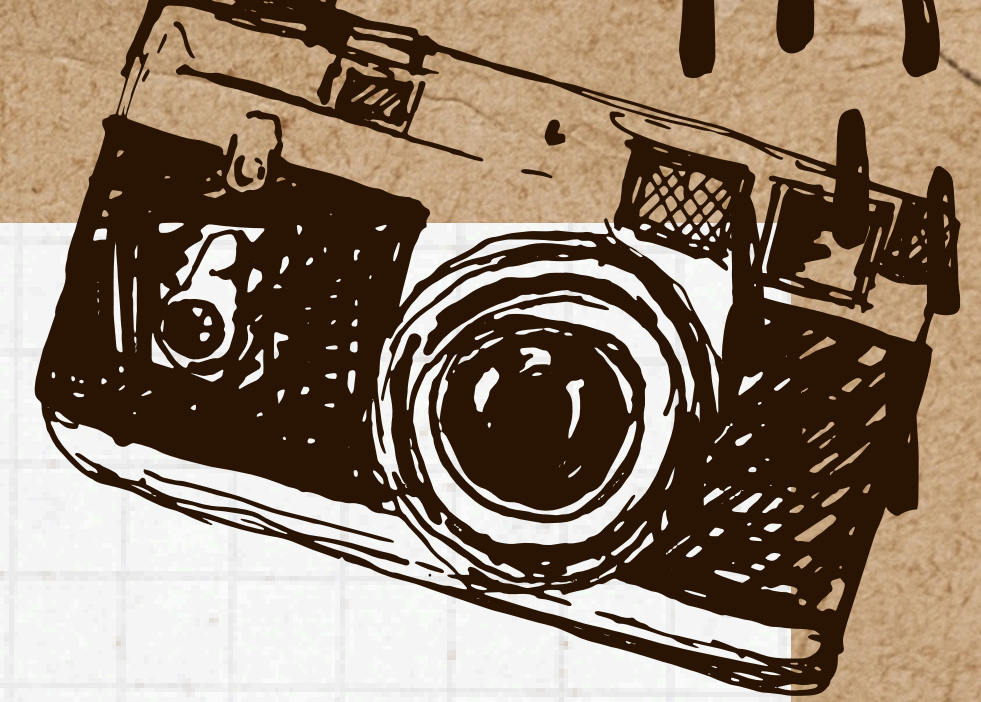


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# NEW YORK

**In summary, New York has a varied climate, with cold winters and hot, humid summers, and pleasant transitions during spring and fall.**



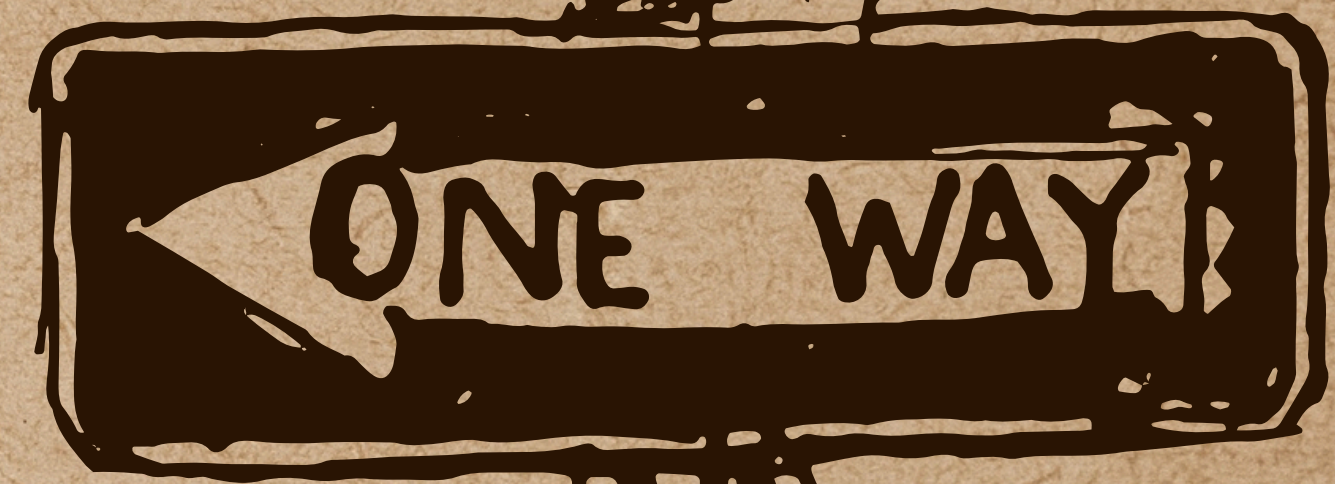

# FOOD
